REVISED REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP)

The Government of Guyana (GoG) invites <u>revised</u> Requests for Proposals (RFP) under a *Build-Own-Operate-Transfer (BOOT)* model for the Amaila Falls Hydro Project, with a minimum installed capacity of 165 MW.

Summary of Scope of Work (delivery point at Amaila):

- I. Hydro
 - Capacity: minimum 165 MW installed hydro dam, plant, and substation at Amaila site, and related works.
 - Creation of a 23 square KM storage reservoir consistent with the Environmental Reports and studies and prior permitting.
- II. Assumption of all geo-technical risks including guarantees relating to the structure of the reservoir and dam.

At this time, interested parties should note that:

- (i) That the transmission network will be built separately
- (ii) That the size of the hydro may be reengineered to take account of changes in turbine technology thus allowing more than 165 MW to be generated and transmitted.
- (iii) The GOG will engage <u>independent</u> <u>supervision</u> of the design and construction, with an agreed Terms of Reference (TOR) between the Parties.
- (iv) The hydro project will be executed via a new "Special Purpose Company (SPC)" and will be issued with all previous permits, licenses, and permissions, as previously existing in April 2015, provided the Developer shall have responsibility for any updates as required by law.

The RFP response should include:

- I. Developer's capability and credibility to execute the project (hydro). Submissions should include (i) a detailed track record of similar projects completed under (a) EPC (b) Operations (ii) evidence of financial ability, including last 3 years of audited Financial Statements.
- II. Details of proposed local content, including sub-contractors, % of project costs that will be locally sourced, and supporting details of same.
- III. Detailed project schedule showing (i) time for design/engineering (ii) time for construction, both in sufficient detail.
- IV. EPC price breakdown (with as much detail) of entire project.
- V. Provide a detailed work methodology including local and foreign costs, and specifications of all key equipment to be installed.
- VI. Describe key contractors and sub-contractors, manpower (local and foreign) during

construction, and details of local content.

VII.Blackline all provided agreements that will
make up the Project Structure, including EPC
contract, PPA, and Government Agreement.

VIII. Provide a draft Terms of Reference for appointment of independent supervision.

The response to this RFP will be used to select a capable partner to work with the Government to complete the project based on (i) the lowest PPA price [based on (a) EPC costs, (b) operating costs including life-cycle costs, and (c) capital amortization] (ii) the timeframes to complete, and (iii) ability to finance the project, secured on a PPA basis.

Only firms or consortiums, with experience building at least 3 large hydro projects (each at least 100 MW) in the last 15 years, will be evaluated. At registration, Interested Parties must submit evidence of (a) prior EPC experience (b) JV or Consortium agreement.

All pertinent information in possession of the Government, including the full EPC contract containing detailed engineering, will be made available upon completion of (i) Registration (ii) Completion of a Confidentiality Undertaking/Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) and (iii) payment of a registration fee of G\$100,000.

Interested companies shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of their response to this Request for Proposals (RFP).
