

Local Content Secretariat NOTICE

Georgetown, Guyana: April 19, 2022

In accordance with the Local Content Act No. 18 of 2021 ('the Act'), the Local Content Secretariat of the Ministry of Natural Resources hereby issues this guidance with respect to the definition of a "Sub-Contractor" operating within the petroleum sector of Guyana. This guidance serves to remove ambiguity and provides clarity with regards to the criteria for defining a Sub-Contractor, for which, obligations are stipulated within the Act.

Pursuant to the Act, "Sub-Contractor" includes any person with whom a Contractor or Licensee has entered into an agreement for the provision of goods and services within the Contractor's or Licensee's supply chain management, and -

- (a) operates in Guyana either:
 - (i) registered as an external company; or
 - (ii) as a company incorporated,

under the Companies Act Cap 89:01;

- (b) has a physical presence in Guyana;
- (c) procures goods and services for petroleum operations; and
- (d) provides the following services:
 - (i) marine vessel support;
 - (ii) FPSO vessel;
 - (iii) Shore Base;
 - (iv) Drilling Support;
 - (v) Drilling;
 - (vi) SURF;
 - (vii) Manpower and Crewing Services; or
 - (viii) any other service(s) deemed relevant by the Minister.
